Teichmanis, an accomplished Latvian 'cellist with a rich variety of tone and a lively intelligence, it never for a moment sounded dull at Wigmore Hall on Saturday evening. —TIMES, 21st February, 1949 An excellent impression was made by a cellist from Latvia, Atis Teichmanis, on his first appearance at Wigmore Hall. Ably partnered by Hugo Strauss at the piano, he played Hindemith's Sonata, Op. II, a difficult work to make convincing, and succeeded by his fine tone and phrasing in holding the interest throughout.
